House Rules



In welcoming you, we remind you that you are in a public place and that the related laws apply. We will also be grateful that you respect other guests as well as the property and the furniture.

- 1. **Animals:** Animals are not allowed, without exception.
- **2. Smoking**: It is strictly forbidden to smoke indoors, in accordance with Swiss law. Ashtrays are available to smokers on the balconies.
- **3. Arrivals**: Arrivals are registered in the café. Arrivals are scheduled between 4 p.m. and 9 p.m. For early arrivals, if the room is not yet ready, you can leave your luggage in the café. For late arrivals, please call +41-27-776 1461 or +41-79-669 0246 no later than 8:30 p.m. Your check-in entitles you to the VIP Pass during the summer with numerous offers, including free buses. For more information, please consult the website of the Tourist Office (verbier.ch).
- 4. Departures are made no later than 10 a.m. Please check that you have not forgotten anything.
- **5. Breakfast**: We provide in the kitchen a coffee machine with capsules, a kettle and teas, chocolate panettones and croissants, butter and jams. You can use the fridge in common with other guests, but we take no responsibility for storing goods there.
- 6. Dining: It is forbidden to eat in the rooms, but drinks are allowed. The kitchen is the place to eat. Cooking is not allowed, but you can reheat meals in the microwave oven. Please respect cleanliness and clean behind you: it's a communal room.
 You have the option to eat in the restaurant on half board. Upon reservation, you can have a set meal for CHF 20.-, otherwise you are entitled to a 15% discount on à la carte dishes, also upon reservation.
- 7. Cleanliness: We carry out daily cleanliness checks in the apartment and the rooms and clean accordingly. If a deep clean is required, the customer will be charged. We therefore recommend that you unpack your luggage and keep the rooms clean.
- **8. Valuables**: You are responsible for your belongings. We decline all responsibility in the event of the disappearance of your personal possessions.
- **9. Noise**: Please respect your neighbours by avoiding making unnecessary noise, especially from 10 p.m. when we demand silence.
- **10. Children**: Children are under the responsibility of their parents.
- **11. Behaviour**: We ask you to be dressed properly when moving about in the apartment. **Do not leave your belongings in the bathroom.**
- 12. It is **forbidden** to invite guests (friends or family) to the property.
- **13. Generalities**: We strive to keep prices as reasonable as possible. In return, we ask for your cooperation in:
 - turning off the lights if they are not necessary and closing the front door
 - moderating water consumption, especially hot water
 - avoiding overheating the room
 - using only the linen you need and drying it on the clothesline provided in your room
 - by taking only what you need for breakfast, and not taking food and drinks made available to you for breakfast for your picnics (for which you may be charged).
